

## NEW & EMERGING TEACHER INSTITUTE

New teachers need help getting a strong start in the classroom. As they meet the day-to-day challenges of working with students, parents, peers and administrators, they must also adjust to new rules, policies and paperwork.

All of this leaves little time to address the really important questions:

*What are my responsibilities?*

*How do my students learn best?*

*How can I plan effective and engaging lessons?*

**QTL's New & Emerging Teacher Institute** is a six-day program for teachers in their first three years in the classroom. The Centers for Quality Teaching and Learning offers **NETI** to districts to meet the needs of newly licensed and lateral entry teachers.

NETI participants attend a three-day immersion in their district as the school year begins. These initial sessions are designed to provide a strong awareness of the roles and responsibilities of teaching and a clear understanding of how to approach curriculum standards and the tools of instruction.

During the school year, three days of additional instruction help ensure that teachers are not only surviving, but thriving in the classroom. The goals are three-fold: to help new teachers become more effective right from the start, to increase their job satisfaction, and to keep them in the classroom for years to come.
